Dear Rev. Fathers, Sisters, Brothers and Lay Faithful,

Greetings from Bishop's House, Kohima !!

We are in the month of July and most of our schools are on holidays especially those in the Hills and others will have it in this month. This is also the season for cultivation for most part of Nagaland. We continue to support our people with our prayers so that God may reward them with the fruit of their labour – a plentiful harvest.

Summer holiday is also the time when many of the parishes/centers can and should organize special bible/catechism camps in the parishes and centers. It gives the opportunity for those who do not study in our schools to come together and learn more about our faith. Therefore I request all the parish priests/ center in-charges to hold such camps during the summer holidays.

We are having monsoon rains which are causing hazards and havoc, especially with landslides that block travels in most places. Kindly take care while travelling. As you know the road to Imphal is totally cut off for heavy vehicles, which will affect the classes at St. Joseph College (autonomous), Jakhama. We hope and pray that the authorities will restore the traffic at the earliest.

I will be away from the diocese for five weeks for the mission appeal in the US from July 1st, 2025. This year Fr. Sunny Joseph and Fr. Anto C.P. will also be joining me for the mission appeals. Kindly keep us in your prayers. **During my absence Rev. Fr. Carolus Neisalhou, the Vicar General of the diocese will take care of the ordinary administration of the diocese.** I am expected to return on 6th August 2025.

Vocation Camps – 2025

As you are well aware and informed the dates of the first vocation camp had to be changed since we hosted the 5th Regional Youth Convention 2025. Now the first vocation camp will be held from 4-7 July 2025 at Kiphire. The dates of the second vocation camp remain the same (October 03-06, 2025, at Holy Cross, Dimapur). As per the policy of the Northeast Bishops any congregations that has house in the region can come and talk to the children during the vocation camp with permission and as per schedule from the vocation Director. As a diocesan policy we do not permit any religious groups to visit parishes and centers to recruit vocations in order to avoid unnecessary rivalry, competition, strained relationship, etc.

Retreat for Priests and Sisters

I thank Fr. Joy Joseph Arackal, from the Diocese of Alleppey, who came to animate this year's diocesan retreat. He is an accomplished moral theology professor. This year we had to make some changes in the dates due to the 5th Regional Youth Convention hosted by our diocese at the Cathedral Campus. The Sisters retreat was concluded on Thursday (June 26). 
